Name	Squares x Squares =	Area
Barbecue	8x4	32 squares
Patio	8x4	32squares
Bike Shed	2x4	8 squares
Veg Patch	5x6	30 squares
Lawn	10x6 =60 -4	56 squares
Shrubbery	3x6	18 squares
Garden Shed	5x4	20 squares
Flower Bed	3x5	15 squares
Swings and Slide	6x4	24 squares
Wild Flowers	3x4	12 squares

(2) Area of veg patch, wild flowers and bike shed = $30+12+8 = 50$ squares

(3) How much greater is the lawn than the veg patch= $56- 30 = 26$ squares

(4) Difference in squares between the largest and smallest section =
Lawn - bike shed, $56- 8 = 48$ squares

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- 8) What is the area of the grass and flower bed together? $45 = 15 = 60$ squares
- 9) What is the difference in area between the swings and the roundabout?
Roundabout - Swings, $20 - 8 = 12$ squares

- Astro turf: 6 rows of 10 squares = 60 squares of turf
- Garden path: 2 rows of 7 squares = 14 squares of paving stones
- Office Room Floor: 4 rows of 5 squares = 20 squares of carpet
- Office Block: 3 rows of 8 squares = 24 panes of glass
- Bathroom wall: 3 rows of 9 squares and 2 rows of 2 squares = 31 tiles
- Shop Floor: 3 rows of 7 squares and 3 rows of 10 squares = 51 floor tiles
