Dear young people from 6th class, St. Aidan's School,

I know many of you have been preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in our parish on Friday 29th May. Myself and the whole parish team share your disappointment, along with your teachers, school staff and families.

Unfortunately, we can't say when we will be able to proceed with Confirmations but rest assured that, while it might take time, we are committed to the class of 2020 receiving the Sacrament when and however it is possible. This is a testing time for all of us, including with our life of friendship with God. Faith in God is always about trusting in 'a bigger picture', especially when life is tough. - Try to stay cheerful and happy, even though you miss your friends and school community.
- Do what you can to help out at home, in other words..... be the <u>BEST</u> version of yourself.
- Look up the gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit. Pick one each day and ask yourself what that gift/fruit of the Holy Spirit looks like in your life at the moment. What might you do differently to help that gift/fruit to grow. When you've gone through all the gifts/fruits ... start again. We can never exhaust the gifts God wants to give us.
- Be gentle and kind (two fruits of the Holy Spirit) with yourself and your family.

I'm really aware that this is also a big year as you graduate from primary school and move on to new adventures in secondary school. Don't be afraid. Dream Big and enjoy life opening up before you.

Myself and all the parish team will continue to pray for you all each day. Will you pray for us too, please? Please God, as things start to settle down a little, we will be able to plot a new way of receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation for all those who want it.
