## Vertical



Straight line up and down

## Horizontal



Straight line left and right

## Diagonal



Straight line corner to corner

## Parallel



Lines that will never meet and are always the same distance apart.

## Perpendicular



Lines that meet at a right angle ( $90^\circ$ )

## Intersecting Lines



Lines that cross but do not make a right angle.

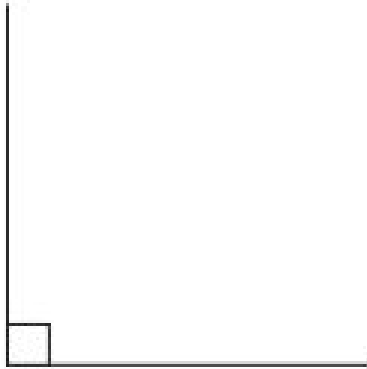

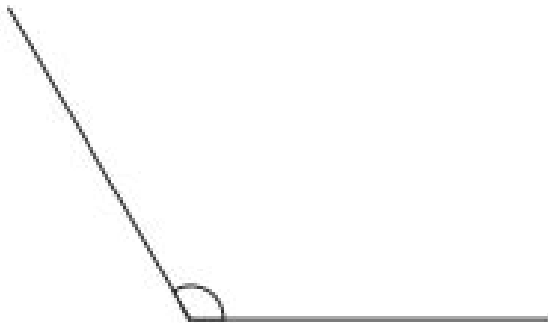

Right Angle - a square  $90^\circ$ .



Obtuse Angle - is greater than a right angle but less than a straight line (as anything over  $180^\circ$  is a reflex angle).



Acute Angle - is smaller than a right angle.
