Here are some instructions for a craft activity. You'll notice that some of the words are missing! Try your best to fill in the blanks, and then get crafting!

How to make a paper plate beetle

You will need:

Small paper plate
Black paper or card
Paint (we used blue but you could use any color)
Black marker pen
Glue

Method: (or Instructions/Directions/Steps)

1. First, paint your paper plate and leave it to dry.
2. When your plate is dry, draw on the markings of your beetle with a black marker pen.
3. Take/get black card and cut two small straight black legs, two longer straight middle legs, two bent front legs and two pincers.
4. Stick/Glue these to the underneath of the plate rim.
